Project idea:

MedOn: Reconciliation Therapy

What if it were possible to gather in one platform all the information about the medication that a patient is taking, so that the different health professionals could make prescriptions decisions in a more enduring way, avoiding duplication, adverse effects and other problems?

MedOn will allow doctors, nurses and pharmacists to gather in the same space all the medication of a patient. It is a platform that allows us to respond to a lack of security in the use of medication and the transmission of information in a correct way.

Expertise: technology and solutions

This project is based on four pillars:

- Online portals: 1) to the doctor: to validate and reconcile all medication and other relevant patient information; 2) to the pharmacist: to reconcile the different medication.
- Medication card and application for the patient: accompanies the patient in the transition between health care and in which he can register the medication, which the doctor will then validate.
- Indicators: that allow monitoring, to be able to assess the impact - both health and financial - that the tool has in the National Health Service, measuring from the reduction of adverse effects to hospitalizations and costs.
- **Added-value:** easy access to the clinical information, better organization and traceability of data, comparison and correction of medication errors in a shorter time, optimization of the treatments performed
- **The solution is fully interactive and independent of any other medical platform.**



Next steps, objectives and current consortium

Next steps:

- At the end of 2018, the solution will be piloted in the Hospital Center of Covilhã. At the beginning of 2019, it will advance to other hospitals and health centers. The next step will be to reach community pharmacies.

- MedOn has other potentialities, such as nursing homes, where there are clinicians who accompany the sick and need to know all the medication the patient is going to do.
